**Overview of Transcript Requirements to be Eligible to Enter the
PPBOCES/UCCS Teacher-in-Residence Program (TIRP)**

Reviewing the transcript of a candidate to the TIRP is an important step in the application process. All transcripts must be from an accredited four-year college or university. The accrediting agencies that TIRP accepts are listed below.

To qualify to enter the TIRP, the candidate’s transcript must include thirty (24) specific credit hours in the subject area in which the candidate would like to receive a teacher license. To review the specific credit hours required for each licensing area, click on the licensing area of interest listed after the Overview in this portion of the TIRP website. Please be sure to check the test required as well.

If your transcript is lacking any of the required credits, you must make arrangements to get those credits during the two year timeframe you are in TIRP. This is conditional based on having already passed the content when you apply to TIRP. If you have not passed the content test then you must have the 24 credits to be eligible. You would have to take and pass the content test within the two year timeframe while in TIRP. You can get the credits by taking a college course (traditional classroom course or online) or you can “test out” of some credit via the DSST (Dante) or CLEP programs.
